**Kevin Terrell, D.O., M.S.**

Dr. Terrell is a specialist in emergency medicine; specifically as it pertains to older adults. His current research, funded by the NIH, deals with analyzing previously developed quality indicators for transfers of care between nursing homes and emergency departments, and the formal testing of an intervention to improve the emergency care of nursing home residents.

Dr. Bowles is Associate Professor at the Penn School of Nursing, the Beatrice Renfield Visiting Scholar for the Visiting Nurse Service of New York, Senior Fellow in the Leonard Davis Institute, and Director of the Health Informatics Minor. Dr. Bowles leads a program of research in the use of information technology to improve healthcare for elders. She recently completed an NIH funded study that developed an expert decision support system for hospital post acute care referral decisions for older adults.
